We are enthusiastic about artists' most recent endeavors and art forms that propel contemporary production and incite conversation.

Exhibitions will be juried and curated by this town is small and The Guild, and will be mounted in the Gallery @ the Guild, with the duration and structure of the shows being determined in part by the volume of submissions. Exhibitions will be programmed in July, August, and September 2018.
